Clothing

- USCG Approved Life Jacket (PFD)
- Lightweight quick dry t-shirts
- Lightweight long sleeve quick dry
- Water shoes (non-marking)
- Comfortable walking shoes (non-marking)
- Swimsuit x 2
- Convertible pants or quick dry pants
- Full brimmed hat - with chin strap
- Spare hat - baseball cap
- Lightweight rain jacket
- Underwear x 3+
- Bandana or 'buff' for sun protection
- 3 pairs socks - quick dry, not cotton
- Wear your Class A when arriving

Sleeping Gear

- Summer sleeping bag or sheets
- Sleeping pad
- Small pillow
- Ear plugs

Other Essentials

- Provided Duffel Bag *
- Crew Logbook *
- Sailing gloves
- High SPF Sunscreen - 50+
- Insect repellent wipes - not spray
- Polarized sunglasses with strap
- Headlamp with extra batteries
- Small bottle of biodegradable soap
- Baby wipes (to be thrown in trash only)
- Small knife if desired
- Toothpaste and toothbrush
- Dry deodorant - not wet
- Small towels - synthetic, not cotton
- Water Bottle** (with carabiner)
- Chapstick (with SPF)
- Baby Powder (non-talc) in travel size

- Gold Bond ointment
- Personal Medications (notify your VBO)
- Small First Aid Kit if desired

Eating & Fun Money

- \$\$ for a meal at port
- \$\$ for souvenirs at port

Optional items

- Books or journals (small ones!)
- Class B T-shirt with your Ship logo
- Camera/Cellphone - waterproof case?
- Anti-itch cream (hydrocortisone)
- A&D Ointment to prevent/soothe rash
- Frisbee/bocce ball/hacky sack /cards

DO NOT BRING

- Electronics other than cameras or cell phones
- Any form of a weapon
- Fireworks, flares, etc.
- Any type of pressurized aerosol cans
- Any shoes that mark the boat deck

(*) A pre-cruise package will be provided to each participant that includes a Crew Logbook and custom duffel bag. All participant gear **MUST fit in the provided duffel bag!** The only exceptions are your life jacket (PFD), sleeping pad, and musical instrument.
